


On-board unit registration



Setting of vehicle category*

on the HU-GO portal means that both the declaration of road usage and the calculation of road usage cost are based on the JDB category (number of axles) as it stated by the road user on the Vehicle Properties page of the www.hu-go.hu site.

with the use of Toll Declaration Operator means that the declaration of road usage and calculation of road usage cost is based on the JDB category info coming from the OBU - if the OBU provider can supply this information. Of course, when the OBU cannot provide such information, the usage will be declared and the cost will be calculated based on the JDB category value declared by the road user on the Vehicle Properties page of the www.hu-go.hu site.
